THE HUMAN PERCEPTION OF RISK

As established by the State-Regions Agreement of July 7th, 2016, updates valid for all security subjects can be taken advantage of via e-learning delivery methods.

Training purposes: the course aims at helping participants acquire notions about the functioning of human perception and memory, focusing in particular on the distinction between perception of and inclination towards risk.

Attendance Certificates: Each participant will receive, upon taking and passing a test with a positive score, a certificate valid throughout the country, according to the State-Regions Agreement of December 21st, 2011. The documentation will be transmitted, on IT support, personally to each user who will be able to download both the Certificate of Attendance and the Citizen's Training Booklet directly from the platform.

Total duration of the course: 1 hour

Expected update: The minimum duration of the update modules varies according to the type of subjects that must be trained (Annex II of the State-Regions agreement of July 7th, 2016).

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR USING THE PLATFORM

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Registration procedure: User registration on the platform.

Skills and entrance qualifications: Learners must have the opportunity to access the technologies used, familiarity with the use of the computer device chosen to use the course (Computer or Tablet) and a good knowledge of the language used.

Methods for the Tracking of the Activities: Each AiFOS course is created in compliance with the international SCORM 1.2 standard.

The use of this model allows AiFOS to ensure the tracking, on its platform, of all the participant's data and the use of educational objects.

The traceability of platform data, user accesses and certificates is kept by AiFOS, within the terms established by law. The platform is equipped with the LMS management system, able to monitor and certify:

- The carrying out and completion of the educational activities of each user
- The traceability of each activity carried out during the connection to the system and its duration
- The traceability of the individual teaching units structured in Learning Objects, which contain a series of tools, such as the text of the lesson, the audio explaining the topics, documents for in-depth study, short example videos and animations.
- The modality of the learning assessments and the passing of the same.

Time of availability of use: The course foresees a duration expressed in hours.

The period of time available to complete the entire course, from the time of purchase, is 60 days, unless otherwise agreed upon with the management.

Methods of Assessment of Learning: The assessment of learning is carried out by administering **intermediate tests** useful for self-learning, foreseen for each teaching unit, and a **final test** aimed at consolidating the knowledge acquired during the entire course.

Each final test includes 10 multiple choice questions (each consisting of at least three alternative answers) based on the type of course. The final outcome of the same is considered positive if at least 70% of the questions are answered correctly.
