(Art.37 del D. Lgs. 9/042008, n. 81 – State-Regions Agreement 21/12/2011 – State-Regions Agreement 07/07/2016)

The course, provided by Art. 37, paragraph 2 of Legislative Decree 81/2008, was defined in its articulation by the State Agreement of 21 December 2011. It's supplemented by the State-Regions Agreement of 7 July 2016.

Addresses: Employees of all public and private companies belonging to each class of risk.

Educational purposes: Provide all workers with the basic information on health and safety at work

Certificate of attendance: Each participant will receive a certificate with valid permanent training credit, after having successfully passed the final test, pursuant to the State-Regions Agreement 21 December 2011.

Skills: Students must have access to the technologies used, be famoliar with the use of computer devices and a good knowledge of the language.

Tracking Activities:

The platform is equipped with an LMS management system that can monitor and certify:

- Conduct and completion of the teaching activities of each user
- Traking all activities carried out during connection to the system and the duration
- Traceability of individual learning units structured in the “Learnig Objects”, which contains a set of tools, such as the text of the lesson, audio that explauins the topics, follow-up, short movies and animations.
- Mode and overcoming of learning assessment.

Tracking Activities: The course have a maximun duration in days. The period of use and enjoyment the course is 60 days.

Learning test: Learning is testing by interim evaluation, based on self-rating, and a final test.

Final test provides for from 10 to 30 multiple choice. The test will be complete if you answer correctly at least 70% of questions.
